



Nicholas F. Sherlock, 73, of Henderson, passed away May 20, 2012. Nick was born July 16, 1938 in Kingston, N.Y. He joined the Ice Capades Show in 1959. In 1964, he took a position with the company in the costume dept. In late 1960's, he opened his own company, Pzazz Costumes Designs, in Hollywood, Calif. His company manufactured and designed costumes for TV shows, motion pictures, Elvis Presley, Disneyland, Las Vegas shows, the Ringling Brothers Circus, as well as for many other celebrities until its close in mid-1980's. Nick then worked on TV and stage productions until he became the head of NBC Universal Studios wardrobe workroom in Burbank, Calif. in 1989. He retired in 2009 and then moved to Henderson in 2010, residing there until his passing after complications from surgery. He is survived by his first cousin, Annette Daly and her sons, Christopher and Dennis; he also leaves behind a "family" of friends in Los Angeles and Las Vegas. There will be a memorial celebration of his life in Las Vegas at a later date.
