Mike O'Gara - March 25, 2022



Longtime Entertainment Tonight Executive In charge of Production Mike O'Gara lost his battle with cancer on the evening of Friday, March 25, 2022.

O'Gara was born at St. Vincent's Hospital in New York City and joined the United States Navy, at the age of 17. He skipped across the country at various stations, winding up at Whidbey Island Naval Station, in Washington State and then abord the USS Bon Homme Richard (CV-31).


Following his tour of duty, O'Gara returned home to New York, where he was sitting in a bar across from Madison Square Garden, where the Ice Capades traveling show was playing. Many people were applying for jobs and he got hired on the spot by owner John H. Harris.

In the 70's O'Gara worked at KCET, the public television station in Los Angeles ,as a Property Master and Stage Manager on shows including 'Incident at Vichy', 'Me', 'Steambath', 'The Way It Was', 'Stumpers', 'The Belle of Amherst', and 'Six Characters In Search Of An Author'. He also worked as a freelance stage hand at CBS on shows like 'The Carol Burnett Show', 'The Smothers Brothers' and various network specials.

Cassie Turner - "For my Las Vegas friends and beyond, S&R and Ice Capades friends and family, it is with a heavy heart I share the news of Brad's passing this morning. This was one of my favorite photos of a moment when I had hope. Hope that this kind hearted and generous soul would be able to beat his addiction, and find the capacity to love himself as much as he loved others - both 2 and 4-legged.

To Brad, we can be solaced with the knowledge he is no longer in pain. Wherever you are, I hope your blades are sharp, the ice is gleaming, and the applause is loud with standing O's!" FYI -- No drug or alcohol abuse/overdose. Simply, his body couldn't take it anymore. Thank you again Sonya for your love, caring heart, and generous soul. We all love and appreciate all you did for him, in his last year.

Sonya Shewchuk - I have been trying to get myself together to let you all know about Brad. My heart is very heavy today losing my friend.

I found Brad last August living on the streets of Las Vegas. As most of you know I worked with him to get him off the streets and get some medical help. It was a battle at the beginning but by the end of November he was in a safe place and getting help. He continued to improve and was on a good road. He actually just moved into his own rented place 3 weeks ago and was very excited to finally have a place to call home. I had taken him on a shopping spree the end of March and he looked like a kid on Christmas morning. I was so happy to see him like this. He was happy and had many plans for the future.

His drug use with heroin ended a year and a half ago and he never went back to it. He had a blood disorder that was very painful and he was on doctor prescribed pain medication. He was to have an operation on his eyes next month. He didn't drink but enjoyed his Big gulps! He had the kindest heart I have ever met.

I received the phone call this morning, no overdose no suicide.

I do believe that the blood disorder that was shrinking his veins took his life today.

I want to thank all of you that reached out to him over the last 8 months. He was so happy to know that his Ice Capades friends were still there. He didn't feel alone anymore.

Thank you all so much for helping me as well with Brad. I will miss him so very much. Love Sonya



RELIVING FOND MEMORIES



Doug Martin had published two books called 'Frozen Community' where he wanted to have skaters tell funny stories about their time on the road. Stories were posted before but worth sharing again.

Michael Garren recalls this wonderful memory during the taping of our NBC Special and meeting up with our guest stars, Jimmy Dean, Jimmy Durante & the Supremes.

One of Michael Garren's favorite memories with Ice Capades was the television special we did with Jimmy Dean, the Supremes and the great Jimmy Durante. My first TV special was filmed in Rochester, NY, in 1967. I was going to be on TV. In the chorus, yes, but, hey, how much more exciting could life get for a 20 year old? The opening number featured the Supremes. Autographs! I want autographs!

Lights, camera, action! So the cliché went...and went and went again. We did the scenes countless times, until I wondered, would this ever be over? But I met the Supremes and got their autographs, including Miss D herself, so I couldn't really complain.

Later in the evening I gathered up my nerve to introduce myself to Jimmy Dean, a fellow Texan. He was a huge star in those days. Not as big as the Supremes in my book, but I still wanted his autograph to add to my growing collection. He kindly obliged, adding his signature to my autograph book.

Next I went in search of Jimmy Durante, but as the evening wore on, there wasn't an opportunity for me to introduce myself to him. I was really disappointed. With the taping of the TV special complete, I headed to the airport early the next morning, still harboring major disappointment. I couldn't believe I'd done the entire show with Mr. Durante without managing to get his autograph.

Well I was sitting in the counter on a swivel stool, ready to order breakfast, when I heard that unforgettable voice ask, "Is dis seat taken?" Can't you just hear him? I turned to answer, and sure enough, there he was by himself, on his way back to LA, so we ordered breakfast together and I told him I'd done the show with him the day before. We chatted during our meal, me asking about his career, and he asked about mine, such as it was. I knew I wasn't going to let him go without asking for his autograph. I had tucked my autograph book in my carry-on bag, so I pulled it out and he signed on the page fright next to Jimmy Dean. When the check came, both our orders were on one tag so he paid for my breakfast. And as for the television special, when it aired I managed to get a glimpse of myself, which lasted all of two seconds. Ah, the wonders of show biz!
