



Where were you originally from and what brought you to join Ice Capades?



I was born in Marseille France after my father Tony Romano immigrated to France from Italy. Our bicycle family act 'The Romano's' was hired by Ice Capades in Oct 1967. We did tours with East Co and West Co. Later on I learned to skate and became a line skater for a couple years and never stopped auditioning comedy acts for Bob Turk. I finally was given a spot as a comedian and so toured as Jean Pierre in Continental, West Co, East Co and also did the Japan tour. I left Ice Capades in 1984.

What did you learn about being part of an ice show?

Our family did not know what an Ice show was, as we came from Vegas shows and circus. But that first time we saw the show (as we arrived in Cleveland to join) with 10 spot lights and the white ice, the skaters gliding with smiles on their faces and the music from a full orchestra, we were in Heaven. I remember telling my father that we hit the jackpot. Little did I know that I would end up doing Comedy in the greatest show on Ice.

What are your fondest memories of being part of the show?

It is the night we joined which changed my life. Opening nights. I love the train trips and the travels across Canada and the US. Also as a laugh, my brother locked Johnny Labreque in the bathroom without him knowing (in Chicago) and then yelled "fire".... to this day I'm still laughing.

Where did you end up after you hung up your skates?





I left Capades in 1984 and was offered to go to Holiday on Ice in Europe but decided to switch careers and so stayed In Los Angeles and now live in Woodland Hills, CA with my beautiful family.

My career path took a turn to the movie industry and I became a Stuntman, a Stunt Coordinator and 2nd unit director for movies and television. I have doubled for Charles Bronson, Sir Anthony Hopkins. Worked with many wonderful movie stars of our era.... You might recognize me but you're not supposed to!



RELIVING FOND MEMORIES



Doug Martin had published two books called 'Frozen Community' where he wanted to have skaters tell funny stories about their time on the road. Stories were posted before but worth sharing again. Here's a recollection from **Terry Derfield** with final rehearsals before opening the show. Those who were there will certainly remember the chaos that happened under the watchful eye of Mr. Harris.

My final storey deals with dress rehearsals, which were always very demanding, grueling experiences. But there was one particular dress rehearsal in Washington, DC, that was probably the worst of all. Our first show of the new season was scheduled to open at the outdoor Carter-Barron Amphitheater in Rock Creek Park for the summer months, outdoor ice surfaces couldn't be used during the day, and had to be covered with a tarp to protect the ice from melting.

Our dress rehearsal began at 8:30 pm, the night before the big opening. We had just gotten started with it began to rain. We'd try to rehearse when the rain let up usually only managing a half hour of rehearsal before it would start to rain again. We'd have to go back in our dressing rooms, wait indefinitely for the rain to stop, then start again. After multiple stops and starts, we were only about one quarter the way through our routines, and it was already 1:30 am!

Then the big boss John H. Harris, arrived, ominous and official like bosses are. He decided he wanted to see the show from the beginning, so we stopped mid rehearsal and started all over again. The skaters hadn't eaten since dinner, and the only food available was in a nearby vending machine, which emptied very quickly. The rehearsal went on until sunrise – skating and raining and starving, all under the close supervision of Mr. Harris – at which point, with the sun peeking through the gloomy clouds, the ice had to be covered again. And we'd barely begun rehearsal for the second half of the show. But we were done – with an unfinished dress rehearsal. Everyone went back to their rooms, tired and hungry. Yet we had a successful opening that evening and the audience was none the wiser.

Let's keep Doug's legacy going. I'm sure there are more 'interesting' stories out there from your time in the show. If you would like to share, please send them to me.
